REGISTRATION FEES:

ON CAMPUS

There are 300 en-suite single rooms on the University campus. The cost of bed and breakfast for 3 nights with morning tea/coffee and a packed lunch and tea/coffee on the 2 evenings of the Late Night Extra is £150 per person.

NEAR CAMPUS

An additional 150 single bedrooms are available in Cromore Court and Atlantic Court opposite the University and within walking distance of the campus. They are adjacent to the railway station serving the University. These rooms are grouped in clusters of 4 and 5 with each cluster having a kitchen/sitting area and one or 2 bathrooms with a shower; the WC is separate. The cost for the same package as University accommodation is £120 per person. The lower fee takes into account the lack of ensuite facilities.

There are rooms suitable for wheel-chair users at the University, Cromore and Atlantic Courts. Rooms at the University and Cromore Court will be allocated on a first come first served basis and when filled then in Atlantic Court.

DAILY REGISTRATION FEE

The daily registration fee is £25 and this includes morning tea/coffee, a packed lunch and tea/coffee on the evening of a Late Night Extra.

• **Retired Ministers undertaking paid work in congregations** other than their own e.g. pastoral visitation or similar, may register in their own right.

• Boards of the Church may register persons in their service who they deem would benefit from the Special Assembly.
